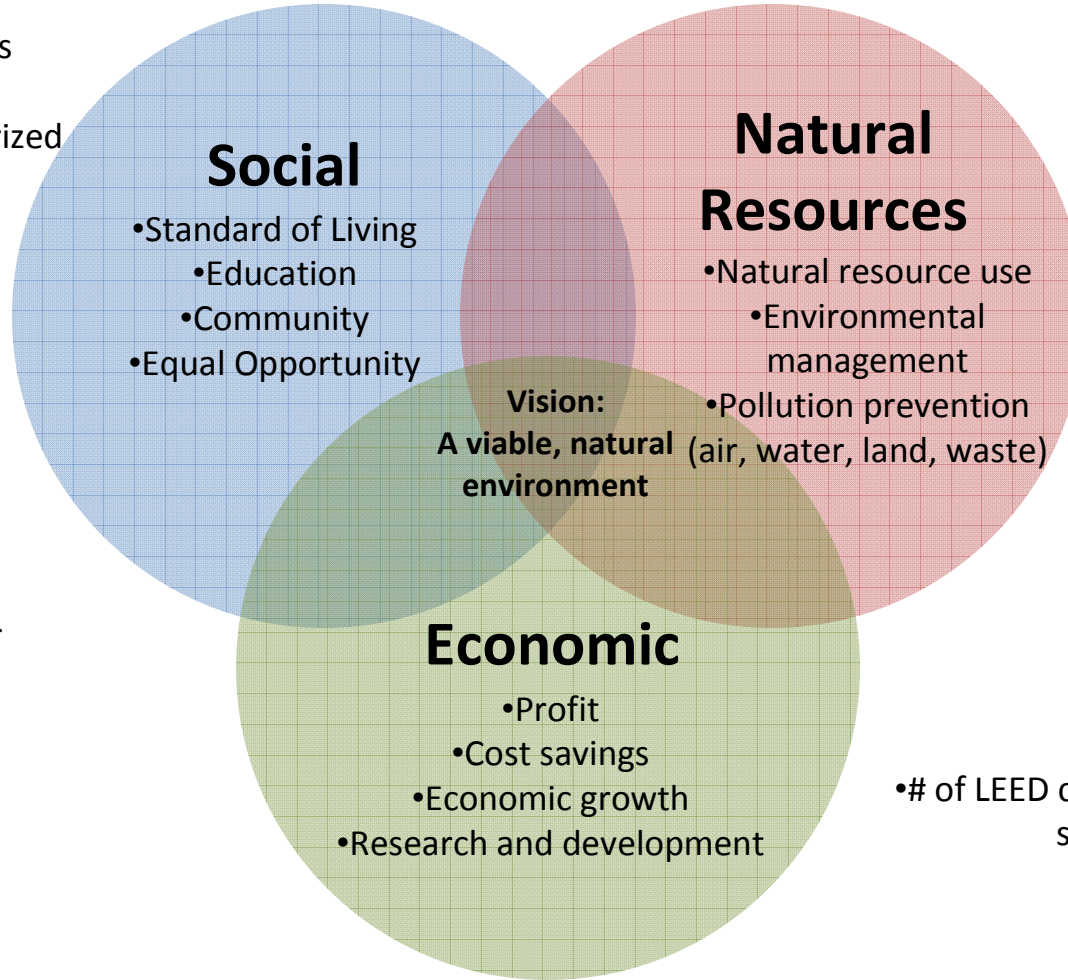


Transportation
