Big Brothers Big Sisters	Big Brothers Big Sisters helps children reach their potential through professionally supported one-to-one relationships with proven results.
Catholic Charities, Foster Grandparents Program	Foster Grandparents serve in volunteer stations throughout the community, including hospitals, shelters, early childhood programs, day care centers and schools.
Communities In Schools	Help a child be successful in school by tutoring them during school hours or helping them with homework after school.
Compeer Program	Compeer is a mentoring program which matches caring adults in friendship with children ages 4-17 experiencing social, emotional or behavioral problems.
Episcopal Social Services	Work with first-time, nonviolent juvenile offenders by leading small group discussion among teens, verify and evaluate written work assist in decision-making and evaluate progress of youth in the program.
GoZones!	Assist school age children in at-risk neighborhoods with their homework during after-school hours or mentor by playing games with the AmeriCorps GoZones! Program.
Grant Chapel A.M.E. Church Tutorial/Mentoring Program for Community Youth, Inc.	This program provides students in grades 1 – 7 assistance in math, verbal & written language skills, as well as social and practical skills. Volunteer tutors and mentors are appropriate role models who stress the importance of education and achieving goals.
Maude Carpenter Children's Home	Maude Carpenter Children's Home provides a long-term home for children who need a safe place to live while their families work through problems or crises. Mentors help with school work and life skills to prepare them for living productive, successful and independent lives.
Positive Connections/USD 259	Positive Connections is the volunteer program which supports all school volunteers in the Wichita Public Schools. This coordinated system supports volunteer management of activities which include tutors, mentors, classroom helpers, and helping hands.
Rainbows United, Inc.	Assist students by reading, supervising field trips, social interaction, computer skills, and all classroom activities.
YouthFriends of Kansas	YouthFriends connects young people with caring adult volunteers in schools with students in grades K-12 to promote success, encourage healthy behaviors and build stronger communities.
