Consideration will also be given to use of these facilities by visitors and tourists to the Wichita MSA and becoming a regional attraction for certain types of activities such as youth baseball, softball, hockey, biking, bowling, football, golf, walking, recreational centers, sporting clays, skating, etc. Implementation of the master plan will be based on meeting the *VISIONEERING WICHITA* Key Benchmarks.
